Intro to Competition Obedience

Location: 1011 E. Willow Grove Ave., Wyndmoor, PA 19038
Time: See our website - SuburbanDogTraining - for Day and Time
FEE: \$160 for 7 sessions **NOTE: class must be for 7 consecutive weeks**

This class is for handlers who are interested in learning the fundamental training skills necessary for competitive obedience including competition exercises and ring behaviors entering, and in, the competition obedience ring. The class is 7 consecutive sessions which may be started at any time.

Be sure to read the instructions on the reverse side before arriving at the first class.

Directions from Germantown Avenue: Take E. Willow Grove Avenue approximately one mile to building set well back on left just before the firehouse.

Directions from Route 309: Take Mt. Airy Exit to south on Easton Road. Turn right on Cheltenham Avenue. Turn left on E. Willow Grove Ave. (2nd traffic signal). Building is set well back on right just after the firehouse.

Building is at the back of the parking lot behind the fence. Enter through firehouse driveway and park on gravel lot. Door is at right end of building.

NOTE: If using a GPS, use Glenside as the town, not Wyndmoor.

- The seven classes must be attended consecutively. If a class must be missed due to an emergency, please notify the instructor.
- Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Unacceptable equipment: chain leash, short leash, cat leash, clothesline, collar with tags attached. All collars except training collar must be removed.
- Before coming to class, your dog should be well groomed with his nails clipped.
- Dogs that are ill are not permitted in class—attend without dog and continue working at home.
- Bitches in season must wear protective garments.
- Your dog must be on leash and under control at all times, indoors and out. Dogs must not visit with other dogs coming, leaving, or during class.
- Do not feed your dog before class. Handlers must clean up after their dogs. Clean-up equipment is available indoors. A trash can and bags are supplied outside. Exercise area is in the vicinity of the trash can - do not let your dog use any other part of the grounds.
- Due to insurance regulations and for safety, all handlers must wear sneakers or shoes with rubber soles. No high heels, sandals, leather soles, bare feet or foot gear determined by the instructor to be inappropriate will be permitted.
- Suburban Dog Training Club, Inc. reserves the right to excuse any dog or handler who is a danger to the class.

Due to zoning requirements, all dogs 13 weeks and older training at our facility must have a valid **Pennsylvania dog license** and a at 16 weeks and older must have current **rabies vaccine certificate**. Please mail photocopied proof of both with your application.

Without proof of rabies and license copy, your application will not be considered complete.
